

EXPLORE WITH YOUR KIT

Your 'Yeti Adventure Tool Kit' consists of several elements that are best explored in different sessions.

THE STOP AND LOOK

Your 'Stop And Look' is an adventure tool to help build focus and concentration.

Use your own tool to find interesting details in your local environment and encourage your children to do the same, making sure everyone has an opportunity to share what they find.



PROCESS PRAISE EXAMPLES

- Look how well you're concentrating.
- You did really well waiting your turn to tell us what you found.
- Great looking ... you found lots of little details there!

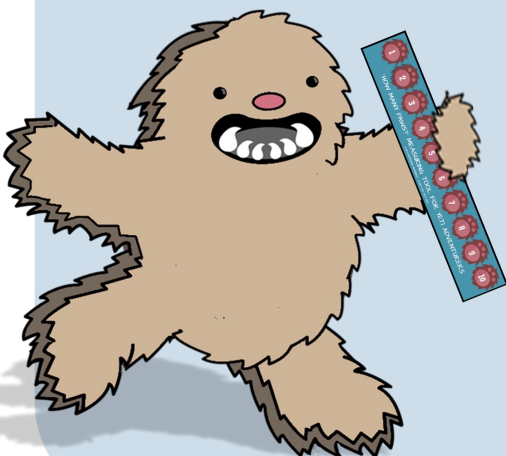
HOW MANY PAWS

Your 'How Many Paws' tool is a simple measuring device to complement your vocabulary keyring.

Use it for comparing, matching and sorting.

PROCESS PRAISE EXAMPLES

- You're doing a great job counting those paws.
- You're looking really carefully.
- You're using some great describing words.



THE SENSES COMPASS

The senses compass encourages your children to explore their local environment in lots of different ways. Turn the dial ... choose a sense ... and start exploring! Expand the comments made by your children as much as possible, bringing in lots of new vocabulary and expanding knowledge.



PROCESS PRAISE EXAMPLES

- Well done, you've done some great searching to have found that smell!
- You're being really careful and gentle with that plant, what can you feel?

THE WHAT CAN YOU HEAR TOOL (OR LOUDER LISTENER)

The sound amplifier can be used to help your children listen to the sounds in their local environment. It might not make things too much louder, but it offers a tool to focus and makes exploring much more fun!

PROCESS PRAISE EXAMPLES

- That's some excellent listening. You must have been really quiet to be able to have noticed that sound.



Don't forget your vocabulary keyrings to remind you to bring lots of maths language into your yeti adventures.
